
# Good Agricultural Practices for Medicinal Plants

Do's Dont's

### Site Selection & Land Preparation

- Get soil sample tested
- Manufacture of the state of the
- Prepare land according to specific needs of the species

Select land having access to clean & reliable source of water



Nourish the soil with plenty of well decomposed organic matter

- Do Not grow medicinal plants in contaminated soil
- Do Not allow people to defecate in medicinal plant field
- Do Not use compost made from city waste and human excreta



## Sowing / Planting


Grow medicinal plants which are suitable to your area




Use only quality seeds or planting material



Sow seeds or transplant seedlings at right season/ time of year



Maintain proper spacing between plants and rows



Prefer planting material from different regions to avoid pest infestation

- Do Not grow medicinal plants

# Good Agricultural Practices for Medicinal Plants


Do's **Dont's** 

#### **Cultural Practices**

- Follow crop rotation practices
- Use mulch/straw to maintain moisture in the soil
- Uproot weeds in time



- Select species that are resistant to local insect pests and diseases
- Take guidance from expert for pest management



Do Not irrigate the plants too little or too much



- Do Not allow weeds to mature & produce seeds
- Do Not grow species that are not adapted to local environment or susceptible to local pests
- Avoid using chemical pesticides




### Sowing / Planting

Use proper & clean tools for harvesting and containers for storage



Harvest material at right stage



Harvest in dry weather





Prefer planting material from different regions to avoid pest infestation

- Do Not harvest weeds along with medicinal plants
- Do Not use recycled bags or those previously used to store chemical fertilizers
- Do Not place harvested material on the ground



Do Not harvest herbs during rain, or early in the morning during dew
